About the Workshop

Session: “Urban and regional economics and policy” (30th-31st May)

The goal of this session is to explore the complexities of urban regional and regional economics. Papers covering different topics on urban and regional economics from a theoretical, empirical and/or policy-oriented perspectives are welcome. The workshop is open to contributions on social, cultural, economic, environmental and sustainability including topics such as quality of life, happiness and life satisfaction. The organisers invite academic researchers, scholars and policy makers to contribute to scientific, technical and/or managerial papers that explore this topic in both developing and developed economies, islands, cities, metropolitan areas, towns and villages. Both theoretical and empirical papers are welcomed.

Session: “Economics of Risky Behavior” (1st-2nd June)

This session will bring together applied researchers working on questions related to risky behaviors to present their research and interact with each other to exchange ideas and network. Many individuals from all ages and backgrounds engage in a wide variety of risky behaviors such as crime and delinquency, smoking, alcohol and substance abuse, suicidal behavior, driving under the influence, underage sexual activity and sexual behaviors that contribute to unintended pregnancy and sexually transmitted diseases, and poor dieting and sedentary lifestyles leading to obesity. These behaviors constitute major source of preventable deaths and injuries, and impose substantial costs on those who engage in them and society. The purpose of the session is to provide a platform for cutting-edge research that would enrich, refine, and challenge our understanding of the causes and consequences of a broad range of risky behaviors, and ultimately to help design policies aimed at mitigating the cost associated with these behaviors.

Submission

Senior and junior scholars (including PhD students) are invited to participate.
